Admission to The John Warner School September 2017

I am pleased to inform you that we have now completed our liaison programme with all of the feeder primary schools and are now writing to give you details about the Induction Programme which is the next stage of welcoming your son/daughter to The John Warner School.

Wednesday, 12th July – Evening Meeting 18:30 to 19:30 in the School Hall

You and your son/daughter have been invited to attend this important evening which will give you the opportunity to find out more about the school and ask any questions. Your son/daughter will be able to meet their Form Tutor and meet the other students who will be in their Registration Group. Students do not need to wear school uniform for this evening. Due to limited space, we ask that **siblings do not accompany you.**

Thursday, 13th July – Induction Day 09:00 to 15:30 and Uniform Sale 15:30 to 19:30

Your son/daughter should attend The John Warner School at 08:45 (ready for a 09:00 start) in their full primary uniform; trainers should be worn for this day as students will be taking part in a PE lesson. A school lunch will be provided along with break time snacks. If you have not already done so then please inform us of any special dietary requirements. Students will finish at 15:30. The Uniform Sale will take place from 15:30 to 19:30 in the school's dining hall.

CATs Test Seat Number for Friday, 14th July 2017

To enable a quick registration process, please can you ensure that your son/daughter is wearing their name badge and that their slip is brought along on the morning of the CATs testing? Thank you.

Friday, 14th July – CATs Tests 08:30 to 12:30

Students should report directly to the **sports centre reception at 08:30** in their full primary school uniform to undertake their CATs test. **Students must bring this letter with their allocated seat number with them.** The day will end at 12:30 and students will be expected to return to their primary school for their lunch and normal afternoon teaching. Please collect your child from the metal gates on the school side of the sports centre car park. Lunch **will not** be provided due to the early finish however, juice and biscuits will be available during the break. Students **do not** need to bring any equipment with them and mobile phones must be switched off throughout the test.
