Gold Duke of Edinburgh Award - Year 12 (Named Students Only)

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest in completing the Gold Duke of Edinburgh award. As part of this award students must complete five sections:

- The volunteering section; must be undertaken for 12 months
- The skill section and the physical section; one undertaken for 12 months and one for six months
- A residential section; the activity can be anything that provides students with an opportunity for broadening their interests and experiences. It is ideal for trying something new or it can be related to existing interests or activities. This must be at least a four day, five night activity undertaken away from home with people you do not know, in an unfamiliar environment. Ideas for residential activities should be discussed with myself before completing.
- The final section; the expedition section. This involves two four day, three night expeditions with two extra days for training and travelling. This must be undertaken in wild country and is therefore led by an outside agency however a member of staff will be on location for the duration of the expedition. We will be using 'Expeditions Wales' for this section. More details about the expedition arrangements will be given once enrolment is confirmed. Provisional dates for the practice expedition are Sunday, 22nd July Friday, 27th July 2018.

Initial enrolment for the Gold award costs £36, this covers enrolment with Hertfordshire County Council, insurance and the enrolment pack.

The expeditions have a set cost of £240 per person each. This includes expedition equipment, training and staffing. One will be undertaken this summer and the other in the summer of 2019. Once enrolment in confirmed a deposit of £90 will need to be paid before 23rd March to secure the expedition places. Final payment will need to be paid by mid-June 2018.

Additional costs include food for the expeditions, and any costs incurred from the other four sections; volunteering, skill, physical and residential. Any concerns regarding these costs please speak to myself or the school Bursar.

The gold award is an extremely challenging but rewarding end to the Duke of Edinburgh programme. Students who complete this section will be invited to be presented with their award by a member of the royal family at an award ceremony in London.

If you would like your son/daughter to be enrolled on the award, please complete the reply slip with the initial enrolment fee of £36 along with the enrolment form attached and return it to Miss Gemma Major, enrolment fees can be paid via Wise Pay.
